

2024 Alameda Commuters Golf Tournament

Conditions of Competition and Supplementary Local Rules USGA Rules govern play except as modified by Local Rules

- Championship Division Commuter Tees (Black tee yardage)
- Senior Division Commuter Tees (Black/Blue combo yardage)
- Super Senior Division Blue Corica Tees
- · Legends Division White Corica Tees
- · Women's Division White Corica Tees

TIES/PLAY-OFF: After completion of Sunday's play any ties for first place will be broken by a hole-by- hole play-off. If a play-off cannot be conducted (decision of the Committee and the golf course) the USGA method of breaking ties (Rule 33-6) will be used.

CHECK-IN: Players must check in at least 20 minutes before the 1st day of play at the check-in table or they may not be allowed to compete. Players who do not check in on time may be replaced by others on the Waiting List.

OFFICIAL TIME: The clock at the starting tee is the official time. Players should arrive at their tee 10 minutes prior to their starting time.

PACE OF PLAY: Please refer to the Player Information Sheets posted for each event.

OUT OF BOUNDS: On South course: defined by boundary fences on #5, #6, #7, #8, #9, #12. Out of bounds on #9 will be defined by white stakes left of the cart path. North Course: maintenance yard between holes 3,4,5 and behind 9 green.

South course:

Holes #13, #14, #15 - Left edge of cart path is a Red Penalty Area (Extends to Infinity, No O.B.)

DROPPING ZONES: Dropping zones are located on the following holes as an additional place to take relief from a penalty area. The 8th hole (behind the green), and 16th hole (behind the green).

NO PLAY NO ENTER ZONES -These areas are marked with Red stakes with Green tips and extend to Infinity (no OB): #16 - Left side of the canal adjacent to hole. (Red stakes with Green tips).

(Note: Play is permitted in the PA to the right side of the canal marked by red stakes).

#18 - Entire right side of hole 18. (Red stakes with Green tips).

North Course:

Left edge of cart path is a Red Penalty Area (Extends to Infinity, No O.B.)

RESOLVING RULES ISSUES DURING PLAY: Play 2 balls in accordance with rule 20.1c. All instances must be reported to the committee prior to leaving the scoring area.

Corica Park is a sand-based links style course. There are a few sandy areas that the Committee feels is a natural part of the course and does not consider as AGC.

LOCAL RULE: If your ball comes to rest in a closely mown area within 2 club lengths of a sprinkler head and that sprinkler head is within 2 club lengths of the green, you are granted free relief only if the sprinkler head is on your line of play to the hole. (Model Local Rule F-5.1)
